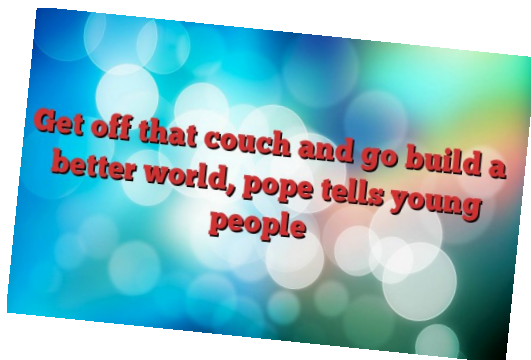




The Foundational Leadership Programme is run jointly between the Catholic and Church of Ireland Dioceses as well as the Irish Province of the Capuchin Franciscans.

Overview of the Programme

- * The programme has **six stages**
- * Each stage has 12 hours contact time plus some personal/independent work
- * The programme will run on one Saturday (10-3pm) each month from **November 2016 - March 2017**
- * Some of the course will also take place **online**
- * The programme concludes with a **Weekend Retreat** in April 2017
- * The Cost of the programme is **€100** which will cover materials and the cost of the retreat

The Foundational Leadership Programme offers participants a unique opportunity to explore and develop Gospel centred transformational leadership skills.

These skills can be readily applied to the participant's own context, situations and background.

The programme is a mix of
