(The word 'premises' below includes anywhere in the premises, grounds or part of off-site activities)

- ◆ Alcohol, smoking or illegal drugs are not allowed on the premises
- ◆ Young People must be at all activities on time and must not leave the premises without the leader's full knowledge, permission and supervision
- ◆ Young People must remain in their sleeping accommodation during the hours laid down and must not change their accommodation without the leader's permission and must NEVER enter the sleeping accommodation or washrooms for members of the opposite sex.
- ◆ The senior assault course and low ropes courses may only be used with leader's supervision
- ◆ In order that the event is a safe and enjoyable experience for everybody, Young People must be generally well behaved and co-operative - in particular, bullying will not be tolerated.

A Young Person may be sent home (at Parent's/Guardian's expense) for serious offences such as (but not limited to) being in rooms designated for the opposite sex, theft, gross misconduct or for repeated offences.
